Practical information

FEE

Registration deadline is **10th of August.** The contribution regarding the **fee for 4 day gathering (incl. accommodation, food, materials, training) is based on the principle – contribute as much as you can and little bit more - between 325 – 450 EUR. In the registration form please indicate the sum that you feel makes it possible for you to take part in the gathering fully taking into account your personal needs for accommodation (please see below).**

NB! The fee doesn't include travelling cost to Estonia and/or venue.

NB! If you are not able to participate, please inform us. Up to 14 days prior to the event, 100 % of the fee will be refunded, afterwards 70%.

TIME

The participants are expected to arrive on Thursday, August 22nd starting at 12.00. Lunch will be served from 12.30-14.00. The gathering will start at 14.00 on Thursday and will finish around 16.00 on Sunday. Each day will start with the breakfast at the venue (8.00), after dinner (19.00) evening program will be offered.

NB! However the international delegates are invited to arrive in the evening of 21st of August.

Prior to the gathering an invitation will be sent to offer car-sharing possibilities.

You are also welcomed to stay longer and enjoy picturesque Southern Estonia after our gathering.

VENUE

The learning journey will take place in Southern Estonia, approximately 300 km from the capital of Tallinn. The nearest town is Võru.

<u>Sänna Cultural Manor</u> is an old wooden house that has been slowly renovated during the last 4 years with the help of variety of supporters. It is situated on the river of Pearl. The manor is a simple house with a library, internet connection and a small shop for organic supplies. In addition to two toilets at the manor, people are encouraged to us toilets outside. Close to the manor house there's a sauna on the river and a small lake for swimming.

As we practice hosting and self-organising during the event, people can support with catering or any other volunteer contribution for the place.

Breakfast, lunch, coffee breaks and dinner will be served at the manor.

If you have any dietary requirements please indicate that in the registration form. Please pay attention that part of the manor's culture is offering only vegetarian food.





HOW TO GET THERE?

Via bus: from Tallinn bus station take the bus to Võru. Suggested arrivals:

- On 21st of August, departure from Tallinn 16.45 or 18.45 for international delegates.
- On 22nd of August, 9.05 from Tallinn, arrival 12.45 to Võru.

The organisers will arrange picking up the participants from the bus station if needed.

Via car: take the road to town Võru, from Võru find the way to Valga main road. Sänna is 20 km towards Valga from Võru.

It takes approximately 3,5-4 hours to drive to Sänna from Tallinn.

You may consider renting a car and stay a few days longer to enjoy Estonian summer.

ACCOMMODATION

Participants are mainly accommodated in nearby hostels and cottages, up to 12 km from the venue, in shared rooms of 2-3 people.

Shared car-rides or pick-ups will be organised.
